One Stall - One Sign

Effective March 1, 2017 all businesses, regardless of employee size will be required to have single user stalls whose signs are gender blind.

The law defines "single-user toilet facility" as "a toilet facility with no more than one water closet and one urinal with a locking mechanism controlled by the user."

The bill's sponsor, Assemblyman Phil Ting (D-San Francisco) issued the following statement:

"California is charting a new course for equality. Restricting access to single-user restrooms by gender defies common sense and disproportionately burdens the LGBT community, women, and parents or caretakers of dependents of the opposite gender. Bathroom access is a biological need. This law will ensure more safety, fairness, and convenience access for everyone."
